## **When you review the COVID-19 vaccine reporting requirements, please consider the following:**

- Vaccine Administration Reporting (NMSIIS)
- Inventory Reporting (Vaccine Finder)
- Temperature Excursions
- Adverse Events Reporting (VAERS)



# Vaccine Administration Reporting (NMSIIS)

## You are required to report in NMSIIS (NM Statewide Immunization Information System).

### Immunization data can be reported to NMSIIS via:

- *Data Exchange,*
- *manual entry, or*
- *the NM Registration App.*



# Inventory Reporting (Vaccine Finder)

## **COVID-19 Providers are required to report inventory DAILY in Vaccine Finder.**

Each provider must log into the Vaccine Provider website at <https://covid.locating.health/login>

Providers must report daily on aggregate doses on hand for each COVID-19 Vaccine



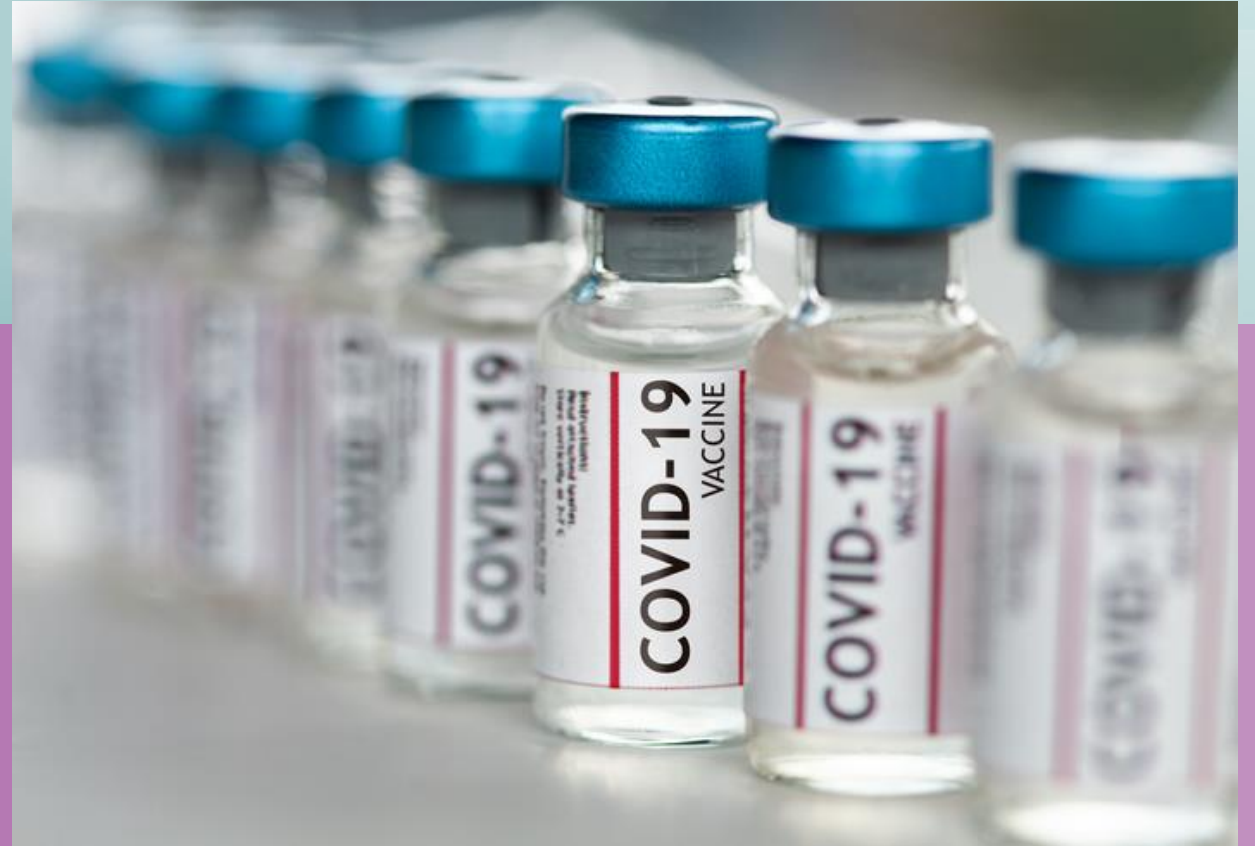
# Temperature Excursions

## Any temperature excursion requires **IMMEDIATE** action by site staff.

Any staff who hears an alarm or becomes aware of a temperature excursion must **IMMEDIATELY** initiate the COVID-19 Troubleshooting process.

Staff members must quarantine and label exposed vaccines “DO NOT USE” and begin the process of contacting manufacturers for viability determination.

***Do not discard these vaccines.***





# Co-administration with Other Vaccines



# All adverse events or reactions must be reported in the Vaccine Adverse Events Reporting System (VAERS) at the web address <https://vaers.hhs.gov/>

Vaccine administration errors, whether or not associated with an adverse event

Serious adverse events regardless of causality.

*Healthcare providers are encouraged to report to VAERS any additional clinically significant adverse effects following vaccination, even if they are not sure if vaccination caused the event.*
